Dear Parents/Carers,

We have exciting news! We are always looking for ways to acknowledge good attendance fairly. Our attendance team have thought long and hard on different ways to do this and in September we will be launching our Hall Green Attendance Shop.



Children will be given an attendance passport and they can earn stars that they can then exchange for prizes in the school shop. Every Friday, children will be able to add a star to their passport if they have been in school for the whole week and arrived on time. This means they need 100% attendance within a week to achieve their star, they cannot get a star if they are late or they do not attend for any reason (i.e. including authorised absences).

Please note, the attendance shop will replace any other attendance initiatives that we have previously run, such as film day/water fights etc.

We understand that there are valid reasons why children may be absent from time-to time but our new campaign still creates opportunities for children to win prizes/gain stars even if they have had the odd difficult week or genuine illness.

Our Whole School Attendance Target is Each Child to Achieve 95%

The shop will be open on the last day of every half term only, children will then have the opportunity to come along with their passports and exchange their stars for prizes (see above). Children will also be able to choose to save their stars to get better prizes if they wish

We are passionate about children having good attendance in order for them to achieve academically and socially, thus making Hall Green the best school it can be.
