Maths:



Spend at least 10 minutes on numbots and see how far you can get!



Reading:



Can you look at a book with an adult for at least 20 minutes of the day. Talk about your favourite part of the story and your favourite character.

Can you take a photograph of yourself reading in an unusual place and send it in?

Writing:



Mark making and writing on snow day.

- ❖ Talk with an adult about snow: how did it look? Feel?
- ❖ Draw a picture of a snowy day: Make marks, lines, circles, or letters
- ❖ Can you tell an adult about your picture?
- ❖ Can you write your name or a simple word (e.g. *snow*)

Just for fun! Snow day challenges...

- ❖ Make a snowman that is as tall as you!
- ❖ Throw a snowball – measure how far it went using footsteps.
- ❖ Investigate: Where does a cup of snow melt the quickest?
- ❖ Create a safe obstacle course using snow piles!
- ❖ Make a snow angel.
- ❖ Write a word or sentence in the snow using sticks or footsteps.
- ❖ Play a game in the warm!
