Maths:

Spend at least 20 minutes on TT Rockstars practising your times tables.



Reading:

Make sure you read for at least 20 minutes of the day. Who will you read to- a parent? A sibling? A teddy?



Can you take a photograph of yourself reading in an unusual place and send it in?

Writing:

Write a **diary entry** describing your snow day.



Things to Include

- ✓ The **date** and a greeting (e.g. *Dear Diary,*)
- ✓ What you **saw** when you woke up
- ✓ How you **felt** about the snow
- ✓ What you **did** during the day
- ✓ How the day **ended**

Just for fun! Snow day challenges...

- ❖ Make a snowman that is at least 60cm tall!
- ❖ Have a snowball fight – measure how far you can throw it.
- ❖ Investigate: Which material keeps a cup of snow frozen the longest in the snow?
- ❖ Create a safe obstacle course using snow piles?
- ❖ Which shape of snow melts fastest: ball, flat shape, or tall shape?
- ❖ Write a word or sentence in the snow using sticks or footsteps.
- ❖ Play a game in the warm!
