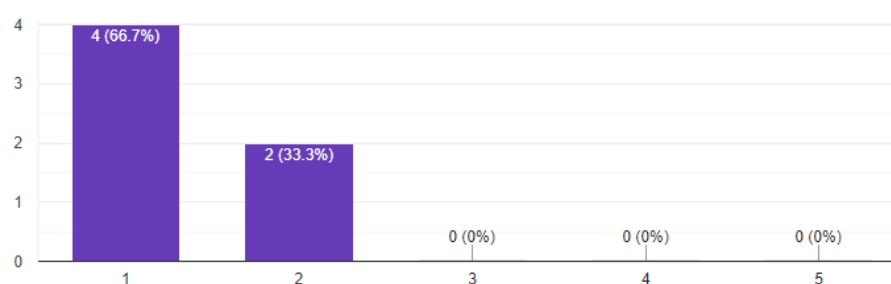

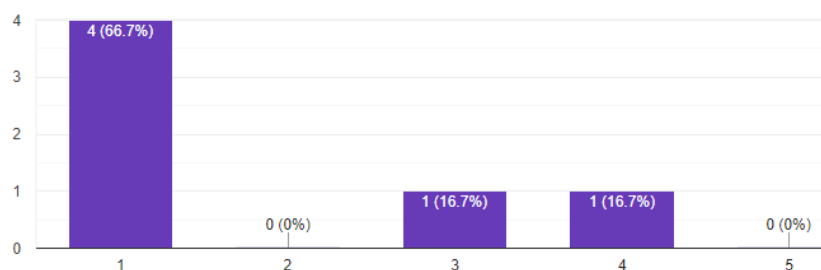

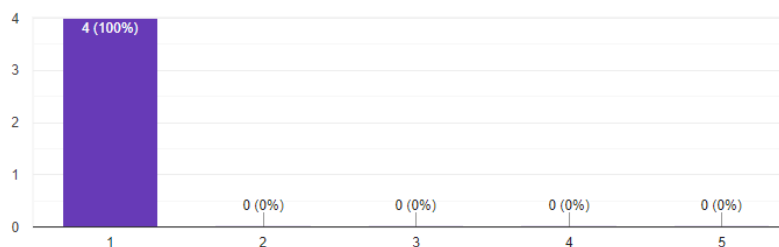

It was lovely to be able to look at the activities the children are working on alongside them.

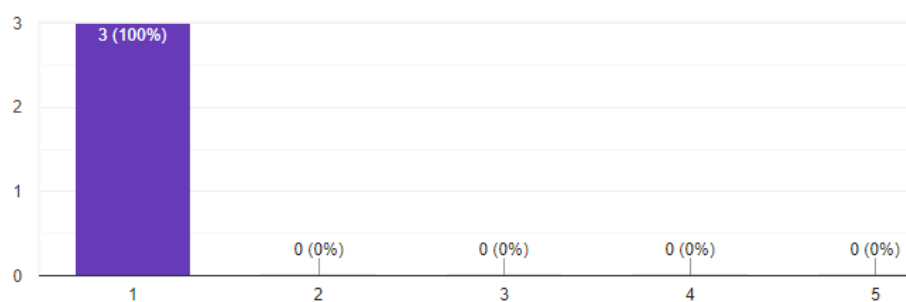

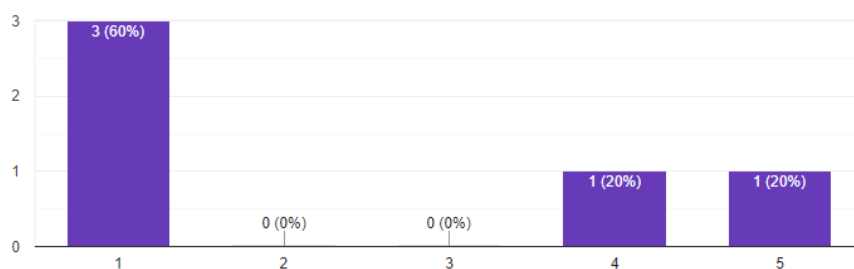

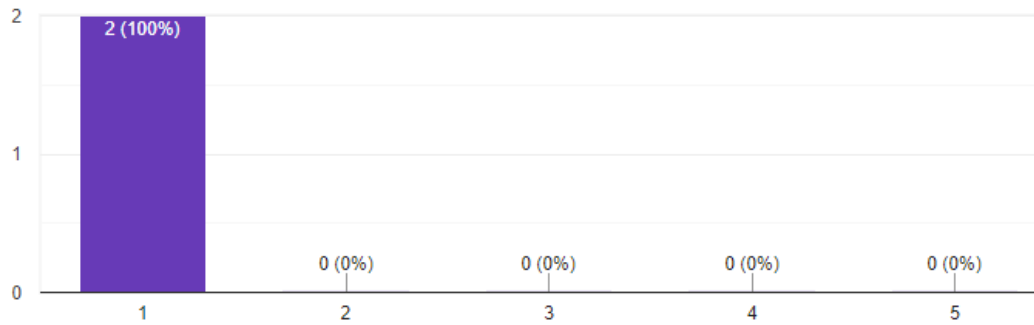

- Continue to consider the time of day of meetings, and try to offer alternative times. We have parents who work throughout a 24 hour period. We immediately upload a copy of the presentation to each year group website page and send a link to all parents.
- Ensure that handouts are provided for parents showing calculation methods and expected writing standards.
- Use the newsletter to remind parents that this was an anonymous survey, if you wish to speak to teacher about individual progress, you are welcome to do so at any time.
- School to consider feedback from each meeting on paper before parents leave. Feedback for these events was electronic and had a very low response rate.
