What are we learning

about this half term?

Maths



As Mathematicians we will be learning about mass and reading scales using g and kg. After this we will look at capacity and revisit scales this time using ml and l. We will convert between units, add and subtract measurements and work out the scale in measuring cylinders and containers.

We will revisit written arithmetic skills for the four operations.



History

As Historians we will be exploring our local history such as the Manor House, looking at its use and change over time.

Computing

In computing we will be programmers introducing block-based coding, focusing on making objects move, setting properties, and using timers to create interactive scenes. Pupils will also learn to fix errors in their code, known as "debugging," and test if their programs work as intended.

RE

In RE we will be finding out about a variety of different festivals. We will be looking at the deeper meaning of each festival and the stories that lie behind them. We will focus on making links between different religions.

PE

In PE we will be focusing on striking and fielding through playing cricket. We will be looking at the techniques of striking a ball, fielding and bowling.

Science

As scientists we will be studying animals, including humans where we will focus on understanding nutrition, skeletons, and muscles. Key learning involves identifying that animals need the right nutrients (as they cannot produce their own food), understanding that humans and some animals have skeletons for support/protection, and exploring how muscles enable movement.



Art

As artists, we will develop our drawing skills using a range of techniques to create our desired effect. We will be exploring a range of mediums, including oil pastels, to work towards our final piece creating a still life drawing of a piece of fruit using Giuseppe Arcimboldo's work as our inspiration.
