As Readers we are using non-chronological reports to practise our comprehension skills. We will continue to read daily in order to improve our fluency and expression.

As Writers we will be writing our own non-chronological report and persuasive adverts. We will continue to focus on improving our basic skills by using technical vocabulary, a range of conjunctions, using determiners, fronted adverbials and prepositional phrases and to use the correct punctuation when writing a report and advert.



What are we learning about this half term?

Computing

In Computing we will be researching what it means to be a vlogger and the importance of internet safety when sharing videos of ourselves online. Children will create a short information video on Seesaw which they can use to evaluate and improve their filming techniques. Then they will plan and create longer vlogs based on our topic.



History

As Historians, we will be learning about our local area with a focus on The Manor House. We will be discussing the importance of The Manor House to our local area and how it has changed over the years.

RE

In RE we will be looking at the Five Pillars of Islam. We will be learning the importance of the Five Pillars and what Muslims do to keep them.

Design & Technology

In D&T we will be developing skills needed to make a Cam Toy. We will research the mechanisms used in a cam toy and develop our technical skills to design and create our own.

Maths

As Mathematicians we will be learning about fractions. We will be counting in tenths, making fraction number pairs and adding and subtracting fractions with the same denominator. We will also look at equivalent fractions and the simplest form of a fraction. Also, we will learn about money where we will make different amounts, compare them and add and subtract amounts.

After this, we will look at time. We will estimate and read the time with increasing accuracy, comparing times and telling and writing the time. During the term we will also practice applying these skills to solve word problems.

Science

As scientists we will be identify, comparing and grouping different kinds of rocks on the basis of their appearance and physical properties. Also, we will be able to explain how rocks and fossils are formed.

Art

As artists, we will be learning about the artwork of William Morris, so that we can practise the skill of foam board printing by creating a repeated pattern combining a range of images from nature.

PE

In P.E. we will be focusing on our striking and fielding skills during cricket.
