

Computing Acceptable Use Agreement

This agreement is to help you use computers, tablets, the internet, and other technology safely and respectfully in school. By following these rules, you help keep yourself and others safe.

- ✓ I will only use computers, tablets, or other school technology when a trusted adult has given me permission and is nearby.
- ✓ I will never share personal information about myself or others, such as full name, address, phone number, passwords, or school details.
- ✓ I will keep my username and password private and never share them with anyone else.
- ✓ I will always use my own username and password to log into approved sites (TTR, Purple Mash, etc)
- ✓ I will not look for, save, or send anything that could upset or hurt others.
- ✓ If I see something online that worries me, is unkind, or is not appropriate, I will tell a trusted adult immediately.
- ✓ I will be polite and respectful when using communication tools like email, blogs, or messaging.
- ✓ If I receive a message from someone I don't know or who hasn't been approved by my teacher, I will tell an adult straight away.
- ✓ Before I share, post, or reply online, I will THINK:
 - T** = is it True?
 - H** = Is it Helpful?
 - I** = Is it Inspiring?
 - N** = Is it Necessary?
 - K** = Is it Kind?
- ✓ I will look after school devices and equipment carefully.
- ✓ If something is damaged or not working properly, I will tell an adult straight away.
- ✓ I understand that the school may check my files, the websites I visit, and the messages I send to help keep everyone safe.
- ✓ If I break these rules or behave unkindly while using technology, my parents or carers will be told and the school may take further action.
- ✓ I will use technology to help my learning and be a positive role model online.
- ✓ I will not try to access websites, games, or apps that are blocked or not allowed by the school.
