

Spelling strategies to help you practise and learn your spellings

Please see the common exception words your child is working on and use the below strategies to help learn them with your child


To help your child learn them use;

LCWC - a strategy where the child looks at the word, covers the word, writes the word, and then checks their spelling.

Overwriting - a child copies the word correctly then writes over the word again and again.

Speed writing - time the child for 30 seconds or 1 minute and they try and write the word as many times as they can in the given time.

Pyramid words- building the words one letter at a time
