Dear Parent / Carer,

In these unprecedented times pupils in Year 6 will have missed out on a significant amount of education. The final term of Year 6 is usually a special time, marking the end of one chapter of a pupil's school life and beginning the transition into another exciting chapter- Secondary school.

Some pupils are often not fully prepared for this transition and find September extremely difficult. If your child:

- Feels anxious or worried about starting Secondary school.
- Is cautious of the size of Secondary school.
- Does not like big crowds.
- · Does not feel like they are ready for Secondary school.
- Is not confident making their journey to school independently.
- · Has any fears or questions about the transition.

The two week summer school at Albright Education Centre could help ease some of their worries. The aim of the summer school is to provide pupils with the skills, confidence and knowledge to help with a smooth transition into year 7. At the end of the programme information will be shared with Secondary schools and things can be put in place to support your child in September.
