SCHOOL DINNERS

School dinners are £11.50 each week (£2.30 per meal). Dinners must be paid for at the beginning of the week for the whole week. Children cannot swap between dinners and sandwiches during the week, they can only change at the start of a new week.



Remember Free School meals for ALL children in Reception and KS1 classes. If you aren't taking up this entitlement because you aren't sure about what meals may be provided, why not ask at the office for a menu?

If your child is in KS2 (Y3 – Y6) and you are entitled to free meals and don't take advantage of them, please ask for a form at the office. Just think of how much money you could save if you pay for dinners now but could claim - Over the year you would save £437 for one child and £874 for two. Now that really is food for thought!

Outdoor Developments

The 6 weeks holidays have seen a fair bit of change at Hall Green. Mr Jevons, our site manager, and other members of staff have been hard at work beginning developments to our school site. In the first week of the holidays, the sandpit was given a major renovation with many members of staff working to empty it, kill the weeds, lay a new membrane and refill it with clean sand.

Mr Jevons has also laid foundations for a new outdoor Science classroom which will hopefully be up and running after half term.

Behind the arena, staff have also been laying garden sleepers to build raised beds that will be used throughout the year as we launch our new outdoor learning projects, which children from all year groups will be experiencing. Tools and outdoor clothing will be delivered this term which will allow children to learn new skills, grow fruit and vegetables, and take learning outside of the classroom at times this year.
