What are we learning about this half term?

Maths

As mathematicians we will cover:

Multiplication/division

- finding multiples, factors, prime numbers, square and cube numbers
- multiplying and dividing by 10, 100 and 1000

- multiplying 3 and 4 digit numbers by 2 digits

- dividing 4 digit numbers with and without remainders

Word Problems

- single and multi-step problems using all four operations

Graphs

- reading and interpreting time tables and line graphs

History / Geography

As historians we will be learning about the Romans. We will study who they were, their leaders and the discoveries and inventions they gave to the world.

We will also look at art and sculpture from the period and even create some of our own!

As geographers we will create our own aqueduct and discuss the transportation of water.

Computing

At artists, we will explore famous pieces of artwork and try to recreate them using appropriate technology.

PE

In PE we will be focusing on Tennis. We will be developing our hand/eye co-ordination, reactions and striking skills. At the end of the half term we will be playing tennis rallies with a partner.

RE

In RE we will be looking at prayer across Judaism, Hinduism, Sikhism and Islam.

Art

As artists, we will make a Roman mosaic tile developing our designing, drawing and printing skills.
