What are we learning

about this half term?

Maths

As mathematicians, we will learn about multiplication and division. We will be learning and consolidating our knowledge times tables' facts to 12 and applying them to solve division problems. Also we will use these skills to:

- solve word problems
- multiply and divide 2 and 3 digit numbers by a one

RE

Computing
