As writers we will be exploring poetry for the first time this academic year. We will be studying 'Chocolate Cake' by Michael Rosen and then re-creating our own poetry linked to good. This will give us time to look at the skills of rhyming patterns and expanded noun phrases. We will then return to looking at character descriptions. This time, it will be linked to 'A Tiger Who Came To Tea.' And we will be describing a character within the story. Building on our knowledge of adjective, noun phrases and the use of verbs to add description.

Science
