We will use organisational devices to help us layout our writing different to fictional writing.



What are we learning about this half term?

Maths



In Maths we will be learning to: solve addition and subtraction word problems (using drawing methods), multiplication and division, (including doubling and halving numbers) and fractions (finding half and a quarter of objects and numbers). We will also be learning to count, read, write and make numbers to 100.

History

As historians, we will be learning about Florence Nightingale. We will be looking at her life and the changes she made to our lives today. We will also be looking at another famous nurse from the past, Mary Seacole, in which we draw comparisons to both significant people and their impact.

Science

As scientists, we will be exploring plants, their life cycle and how they reproduce. As we will be covering the unit during Spring, it'll be a great time to grow our own plants. we will be conducting observations and measurements throughout the whole unit. We will also spend a lesson exploring the elements of the season, Spring.

RE

In RE, we will be focusing on Christianity and the celebration of Easter. We will be making Easter cards.

PE

As Gymnasts we will be looking at creating a routine, which includes shapes, balances and rolls. As dancers, we will be looking at how to move to a beat.

Computing
