



# Hall Green Primary School

## Remote Learning (Non-negotiables)

### Parents will:

- Support their children (to the best of their ability) so that children can access the online learning provided. This includes, but is not exclusive to, ensuring there is a device that children can use (please let us know if you do not have a device or internet connection as we may be able to help).
- Communicate with and contact their child's class teacher either via telephone or class email if they need additional support with the learning being provided, passwords and usernames or if they are concerned for their child(ren)'s physical or emotional well being.
- Wherever possible, engage in communication about their child (i.e. if a teacher calls) and facilitate their child to engage in communication (e.g. via zoom) when required to.
- Under no circumstances screenshot or copy any information, messages or posts to share on social media or any other platform outside of Seesaw. We take the protection of all of our children seriously and will act on any reported incidents that may harm our children or be intended to bring the school into disrepute.
- Ensure children complete the expected hours worth of work each day, as set out in the guidance from the government:
  - Key Stage 1: 3 hours a day on average, with less for younger children
  - Key Stage 2: 4 hours a day
- Paper packs will not be offered in most cases unless there is a

specific reason or exceptional circumstance. Please discuss this with your child's class teacher and get in touch if you do not have a device or access to the internet.

- Keep the school informed about the health of your child. If your child is unwell, please call the office and let them know as you would normally do if they were absent from school.

### **Children, you must:**

- Log onto your remote learning daily and complete the tasks set each day. You are expected to work for as long as you would if you were at school, but the government says that this must not be less than 3 hours each day if you are in EYFS or KS1 and not less than 4 hours a day if you are a KS2 children.
- Remember how to keep yourself safe online and always check with an adult if you are unsure.
- Complete the work set to the best of your ability, asking for help from either an adult/older sibling at home or by sending your teachers a message on seesaw.
- Take pride in the work you produce and check back regularly for feedback from your teachers, responding appropriately. (Every piece of work submitted on seesaw will be looked at and marked by your class teachers as if you were in school).
- Take part in any zoom calls or telephone calls set up by your teacher. If you are unable to attend these please ask an adult to let us know why you are absent or let your class teacher know via seesaw message.
- Follow the expected Hall Green rules when taking part in live sessions. Listen carefully to any new rules for Zoom meetings to help the meetings be fun!
- Keep us up-to-date! We are here to support you with what ever you need and you can always message us on seesaw or call the school if you need to talk to an adult.
