What are we learning about this half term?

English

As readers, we will be exploring themes in our class book: *The Last Wild* by Piers Torday. The first book in a trilogy. We will also explore a range of non-fiction texts and the feature they contain.

As writers, we will make links to this text, producing a non-chronological report and a formal letter, once we have completed our 'Place Value of Punctuation and Grammar' unit.

History

As Historians, we will be exploring the role of the Scandinavians within the UK. We will be studying where they come in the chronology of History and the impact that they had on civilisation today.

Music

As musicians, we will be looking at pop and soul, the impact they have had on music today and trying to replicate vocalist's individual styles using Charanga and a variety of music samples.

Computing

In Computing we will be looking at staying safe online, building positive relationships with peers and technology and we will look at individual digital footprints.

RE

In R.E. we will be studying Hinduism, the role of karma and Hindu's belief of the afterlife.

Spanish

In our MFL sessions, we will be looking at the fundamentals of the Spanish language and how to greet each other.

Maths

As mathematicians we will be delving into place value, the role of number and the four calculation methods. We will be increasing fluency, competency and understanding through reasoning problems.

Science

As scientists, we will be exploring taxonomy and how we can classify all living things. We will be looking at the role that Carl Linnaeus had on the way we understand the animal kingdom.

PE

In PE, we will be looking at team invasion game-hockey being our main focus.

PSHE

In our PSHE sessions, we will be exploring mental health, positive and the negatives, the stigmas surrounding mental health, coping strategies and growing and changing.
