



What are we learning
about this half term?

English

As readers, we will be exploring themes in our class book: 'The Hunger Games' by Suzanne Collins. We will also be discussing themes that run through a variety of different poems.

As writers, we will make links to this text, producing a newspaper report and a short story. Accompanying this we will be writing three different types of poems.

Geography

As geographers, we will be researching energy sources, renewable and non-renewable, debating the effects in the environment- including pollution, global warming and land use, exploring economy sectors and the impact energy has on the economy, whilst also delving into the connections of trade and politics. We will finish with an exploration of innovative renewable energy sources to look at becoming a more sustainable civilisation.

Art

As artists, we will be using a range of media to imitate artists style- looking at both contemporary and historic artists. We will build on our skills sessions to create our individualistic final piece.

Computing

In Computing, we will be exploring the role of directors and how films, trailers and adverts come to fruition. We will be using a variety of apps, including iMovie and a green screen app, to create our own individual film trailers.

RE

In R.E. we will be studying Christianity and the world that Jesus would want.

Spanish

In our MFL sessions, we will be looking at the classroom. Naming items that you may find within the school and whether the children have it in their possession.

Maths

As mathematicians we will be delving into fractions decimals and percentages whilst building on our arithmetic proficiency through focused started and rapid recall tasks.

Science

As scientists, we will be studying the topic light. We will be experimenting the manner that it travels, how it reflects, refracts and can be absorbed.

PE

In PE, we will be looking at net and wall games- this will be with focus on badminton.

PSHE

In our PSHE sessions, we will be exploring keeping safe within a variety of environments and relationships, both family and friends.
